**RESCISSION OF STANDING ORDER
ON SUPPLEMENTAL JUDGE ASSIGNMENT ON CRIMINAL MATTERS**

After the creation of a new judgeship effective April 28, 2016, and in the interest of improved judicial efficiency, the Judges of the Superior Courts created a supplemental case assignment system to balance assignment of cases with the goal of allocating a sufficient number of cases to equalize the workload among the active Judges of the Superior Court. A review of case assignments indicates that balance has been substantially achieved.

Effective the first day of the April, 2017, term of Court, the Judges of the Superior Courts rescind the Standing Order on Supplemental Judge Assignment on Civil Matters and the Standing Order on Supplemental Judge Assignment on Criminal Matters, both dated May 12, 2016. The Standing Order on Judge Assignment dated May 11, 2016, shall apply to all future assignments.

The Clerk of Superior Courts shall place a copy of this Order on the minutes of the Superior Court of Athens-Clarke County and the Magistrate Court of Athens-Clarke County.
