The parties and Counsel in these actions appearing on the trial calendar for a particular date shall appear and be ready for trial on the dates specified as per Rule 8.4 of the Uniform Rules of the Superior Court, unless otherwise directed by the Court.


With settlement, dismissal or removal of a case from the trial calendar, the cases immediately following the same shall move up and assume the status of the preceding case or cases so removed from the calendar and the trial date specified therefor. Cases not reached on a particular date shall continue to be subject to being called for trial later in the week scheduled for trials in the order appearing on the calendar, unless otherwise directed by the Court.

Counsel or a party where not represented by Counsel shall be under a duty to keep informed of the status of the calendar. Immediately upon settlement, dismissal of a case, or problem with a case, the involved attorneys or party shall forthwith notify the Court without delay.

Cases will be called in the order fixed above except by special leave of the Court or by showing for continuance properly made.

It is ordered that this calendar and order be entered on the Minutes of the Court.
