

**Scheduling Order Setting
Pre-trial Conference on Wednesday, June 6, 2018 at 2:00 p.m.
for the June 25, 2018 Jury Trial Week**

This Order applies to all civil cases pending trial which are attached as Exhibit A. Each case shall be subject to the following scheduling:

May 11, 2018

Dispositive motions shall be filed by 5:00 p.m. on this date.

Motions in limine shall be filed by 5:00 p.m. on this date.

Notices of intent to introduce records pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 24-8-803 (6) and / or O.C.G.A. § 24-9-902 shall be filed by 5:00 p.m. on this date.

May 18, 2018

Defendant's portion of pre-trial order shall be submitted by Defendant to Plaintiff by this date.

Any uninsured or underinsured motorist carrier shall file with the Clerk of Court by 5:00 p.m. on this date a notice of whether the UMC will elect to proceed at trial in its own name or in the name of Defendant as allowed under O.C.G.A. § 33-7-11. The election must also be included in section 1 of the consolidated pre-trial order.

Compliance with O.C.G.A. § 9-11-26 (e) – Parties shall comply with O.C.G.A. § 9-11-26 (e) and supplement all discovery responses by this date. Additionally, any trial witnesses and trial exhibits that have not been previously disclosed in response to discovery requests shall be supplemented by this date.

May 25, 2018

Consolidated Pre-trial Order shall be submitted to the *State Court Judge's Office* by this date. The consolidated pre-trial order shall be submitted by email to the Court at lesley.weise@accgov.com. Plaintiff shall be responsible for consolidating the pre-trial order. [**See further instructions below.**]

Mediation shall be completed by this date. If counsel has not received an order scheduling mediation, please

contact the Tenth District Alternative Dispute Resolution Program at (706) 613-3210 to request that your case be scheduled for mediation.

Trial Depositions - For any depositions to be used at trial, the parties shall file any deposition designations or requests for rulings on deposition objections by this date. ***For any trial depositions taken after this date, any designations or requests for rulings on objections shall be filed within 48 hours of a party's receipt of the transcript.***

June 6, 2018

Pre-trial Conference shall be held at **2:00 p.m.** in *Hearing Room 415, Fourth Floor* of the Athens-Clarke County Courthouse, 325 E. Washington Street, Athens, Georgia 30601. *(See further instructions below.)*

All Motions in Limine and Deposition Designations shall be heard by the Court on this date.

June 25, 2018

Civil Jury Trials shall begin at 8:30 a.m. and continue for the remainder of the week.

Instructions for Pre-trial Order:

§1 Name, Address, and Phone Number of Attorneys who will Conduct Trial: If the uninsured or underinsured motorist carrier is a party, the pre-trial order shall include in this section whether the UMC will elect to proceed at trial in its own name or in the name of Defendant as allowed under O.C.G.A. § 33-7-11.

§19 List of Witnesses: Each party shall identify all potential witnesses by first and last name and shall list the witness's position and/or employer (if applicable). Parties shall not list witnesses by generic or categorical descriptions. Any witness who has not been sufficiently identified shall be excluded from testifying at trial except for the limited purpose of authenticating documents, records, or other exhibits.

Amendments: The Court will not enter pre-trial orders that contain provisions attempting to reserve the right to amend the pre-trial order or to reserve the right to conduct discovery. Amendments will be allowed only upon order of the Court and upon good cause shown.


Proposed Jury Charges: In drafting the pre-trial order, the parties are directed to word paragraph 17 as: "Pursuant to Uniform State Court Rule 10.3, all requests to charge, other than additional requests to cover anticipated points which arise at trial, shall be filed with the Clerk of State Court and a copy submitted to the Court by email to lesley.weise@accgov.com in Word document form at the time of jury selection on the week of June 25, 2018." If a party requests a jury charge from the 5th Edition of the Suggested Pattern Jury Instructions by the Council of Superior Court Judges of Georgia, the party may refer to the charge by number without having to submit the text of charge.

Attendance at Pre-trial Conference / Requests to be Excused: An attorney of record must appear for each party at the pre-trial conference to make an announcement in the case, unless otherwise excused by the Court. The parties may mutually request in writing to be excused from attending the pre-trial conference if: (1) the Court has previously entered a pre-trial order in the case; (2) all parties announce ready for trial; and (3) no outstanding issues exist which need to be resolved prior to trial.

Failure to Appear at Pre-trial Conference / Failure to Present Proposed Pre-trial Order: Failure of counsel to appear at the pre-trial conference without legal excuse or failure to present a proposed pre-trial order shall authorize the Court to remove the action from the trial calendar, enter such pre-trial order as the Court deems appropriate, or impose any other appropriate sanction. If for any reason you are unable to appear on June 25, 2018 please contact **Lesley Weise, Staff Attorney**, at lesley.weise@accgov.com at least 48 hours prior to the scheduled calendar call to request excusal by the Court.

This Order and the attached Calendar shall be entered on the Minutes of the Court and a copy served on the Tenth District Alternative Dispute Resolution Program office.


