

**ORDINANCE FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE CHARTER FOR THE CITY OF
WINTERVILLE**

The City of Winterville, acting by and through the Mayor and City Council of Winterville, desires to amend of the Charter of the City of Winterville pursuant to its authority conferred by the Constitution and the Laws of Georgia. The purpose of this amendment is to remove the Charter's restrictions that prevent the Mayor and City Council from granting licenses to sell spirituous, vinous, malt or other intoxicating liquors within the City of Winterville. The City has complied with all requirements of O.C.G.A. § 36-35-3(b)(1). Therefore, the Mayor and City Council of Winterville hereby adopt and enact the following ordinance:

The Charter of the City of Winterville shall be amended to delete the following from Section 25 in its entirety:

The Mayor and City Council shall be forever prohibited from granting license in any form to anyone to sell spirituous, vinous, malt or other intoxicating liquors within said City of Winterville, and the said Mayor and City Council shall have right and authority to pass an ordinance prohibiting anyone from keeping any kind of intoxicants for the purpose of illegal sale within the corporate limits of said city.



Madison Athens-Clarke Occoee Regional Transportation Study (MACORTS) is the cooperative transportation planning body for the urbanized area including Athens-Clarke County, portions of southern Madison County and northern Occoee County. MACORTS has scheduled a public informational meeting to provide opportunity for the public to review and comment upon proposed amendments to the FY 2018 - 2021 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and the FY 2022 - 2023 Second Tier of Projects. The document outlines federally funded transportation improvements. This notice of public involvement activities and time established for public review and comment on the TIP will satisfy the Program of Projects (POP) requirements of the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Section 5307 Program.
